


IT'S TIME FOR IN-SERVICE TRAINING AT #ISULIBRARY!





Bu kurumlardaki tümleşik erişim, müzelerin, kütüphanelerin ve arşivlerin birlikte daha yakın çalışarak verimliliklerini ve etkilerini nasıl arttırabileceklerinin de göstergesidir.

Müzeler, geleneksel işlevlerinin dışında, sosyal gelişmeler için de bir alan sağlar. Farklı ziyaretçi profilleri, giderek artan kültürler arası diyalog müzeleri çeşitli arayışlar içine sokmuştur. Ayrıca son yıllarda müzeler genel eğitim programları içinde önemli bir yer edinmeye başlamıştır.



Genişleyen dijital hizmetler sayesinde kütüphaneler, sınırlı hareket alanlarından uzaklaşıp hem yeni hedefler belirleme hem de yeni kullanıcı gruplarına ulaşabilme şansına sahip oldular. Yeni iletişim kanalları, nüfusun büyük bölümü için kültüre daha iyi erişim firsatları sunuyor.




Ahmet Ümit


Ahmet Ümit was born in Gaziantep in 1960. He graduated University, from Marmara Department of Public Administration in 1983. Between 1985-1986, he studied politics at the Academy of Social Sciences in Moscow. His poems were published under the name of Street Stash in 1989. His first short story book, Barefooted Night, was published in 1992. A Voice Divides the Night, Agatha's Key, and the detective story books The Devil Is in the Details followed. He tried a different style with the books Tale Fairy Tale In and The Land Without Fairytales for both children and adults. His first novel, Fog and Night, written in 1996, was considered a masterpiece in detective literature. His works have been translated into more than twenty foreign languages.










SUGGESIIONS FROM THE LIBRARIAN




