We replaced the library automation program with the KOHA Open Source Coded Automation Program, the discovery tool with SUMMON, and the remote access system with OpenAthens in order to provide services at international library standards, to increase the service quality and to better support your work. In addition, in order to support academic research and intellectual development, purchases and subscriptions were initiated for 31 databases. We will also provide training for you to use databases effectively. We will share the training calendars with you soon.

AUTHOR OF THE MONTH

HERMANN HESSE

(JULY 2, 1877 - AUGUST 9, 1962)

One of the most important writers of the 20th century, Hermann Hesse was born in 1877 in Calw, Germany.

He wrote his first poem at the age of twenty-five and became a freelance writer in 1904, reaching more than 100 million readers worldwide with his novels, stories, essays, poetry, political articles and cultural critical writing.

He received the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1946 and the Pour le Mérite Prize in science and art in 1954.



Thanks to its diversity and versatility, modern AI is widely used not only in science, business, healthcare and education, but also in art, design and music. Thus, it helps us to discover not only new planets and medicines, but also new aesthetic forms.
