



# SEPTEMBER 8 INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY




According to UNESCO data, while 68% of the world's population was literate in 1979, this rate reached more than 86% of the world's population in 2019.



In accordance with Article 7 of the 62nd General Assembly of the United Nations held on 8 November 2007, 15 September was declared as the International Day of Democracy.









# What Do We Know About Predatory/Dubious Journals?

Journals in the Q1, Q2, Q3 classes in WEB of Science (Whether or not for editorial and/or printing processes)

Journals in the Q4 class of WEB of Science that do not charge editorial and/or article processing charge

Journals that are in the Q4 class of WEB of Science and that are the publication organs of a branch association, university, institute or scientific institution to which only members of the relevant science field can become members, although they charge fees for editorial and/or printing processes and national/international journals that have been published/published since 2010 and working as a subscription method



Q4 journals that do not meet the above criteria are included in the category of "Predatory/Dubious Journals".



### NEVER SAY DIE, PLAYING WITH FIRE, UNDER THE KNIFE, IN THEIR FOOTSTEPS, THE APPRENTICE...

Chinese-American writer Tess Gerritsen, who has gained a readership and fan base in our country and around the world with her "The Surgeon", "The Sinner", "Vanish", "Body Double", "Harvest" and many other detective-thriller books, started to be interested in detective books at an early age. Her family tried to keep Tess away from writing. Writing was not going to pay off for her family in the long run, and they wanted Tess to study medicine. For this reason, Tess Gerritsen studied medicine. She graduated from the University of Shestanford with a BS in Anthropology and later went to the University of California, School of Medicine, and then went into business as a physician in Honolulu. Despite her doctor identity, she has not lost her passion for writing and has written various romantic thriller stories. She started to write her first novels after she won an award with these stories.

Although she initially progressed with the romantic thriller genre, she decided to combine her writing with her profession and started writing books in the medical thriller genre. With her first novel of this genre, "Harvest", she quickly became a bestseller and became a great success. The clever fiction of her books, the realistic medical descriptions brought by the author's medical knowledge, the successful transmission of human psychology, and the combination of the author's extremely fluent and exciting pen bring her to the next level in her field. After "The Harvest", Gerritsen wrote the "Rizzoli & Isles Series", which was praised by the critics. The first novel of this medical thriller series was "The Surgeon", which was also very popular in our country. Detective Rizzoli is a symbol of the author's passion for crime, while Dr. Isles is an image of the author's medical identity. Tess Gerritsen, who has a growing fan base around the world, lives in Maine and continues to produce her exciting works.
