

I wish that the summer term, which will be very busy due to the preparations for the next academic year for the ISU Library, will be full of beauty for the entire Istinye Family.



Effective Scientific Article/Book Writing and Publishing Workshop









Our preparations for the Vadi Campus Library continued at full speed.






The Vadi Campus Library continues to serve its researchers with its new interior layout.


Muazzez İlmiye Çığ



Muazzez İlmiye Çığ, who was born on June 20, 1914 in Bursa, is a Sumerologist, scientist and historian. After enrolling in the Hittitology Department of AU Faculty of Language, History and Geography she took Sumerian and Akkadian languages lessons from Benno Landsberger. After graduating from Ankara University in 1940, she was appointed to the Istanbul Ancient Orient Artifacts Museum as a Documents Archive specialist and worked at the museum for 31 years. During this time, together with her friends, she cleaned tens of thousands of tablets written in Sumerian, Akkadian and Hittite languages, divided them into classes and numbered them.

Muazzez İlmiye Çığ, who has worked in many domestic and international events in her field, retired in the field of Archeology in 1972, but after her retirement, she started to live abroad and started to work abroad. As a result of her researches and studies with Kramer, she collected the missing information by bringing new subjects to the Sumerian Literature.

In 2000, due to her work, Istanbul University awarded her an Honorary Doctorate. According to Muazzez İlmiye Çığ, the 3 most important things in life are **love**, **friendship** and **self-confidence**.








A ZIBRARIAN RECOMMENDS





"Nature, Gardens, Dreams" exhibition in Elgiz Museum; It offers the opportunity to recall the relationship between art, nature, garden and people through works compiled from the Arkas Collection. The exhibition, which brings together the unique perspectives of important artists from Turkey and abroad, selected from different fields of art such as painting, sculpture, decorative arts and textile art, reveals the change in artistic production from the 16th century to the 20th century.

The garden, which is a part of nature designed as a fictional living space by human beings and is a natural art, appears in the exhibition in bohemian or structured forms, sometimes depicted as the host of the world of myths, sometimes as a place of pleasure, sometimes as an agricultural area. Bringing together the works produced in the periods when nature was not yet subjected to human destruction, the exhibition also aims to remind people that humans are a part of nature and can only exist with nature. You can visit the exhibition, which is free of charge, on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday between 10:00 and 17:00.
