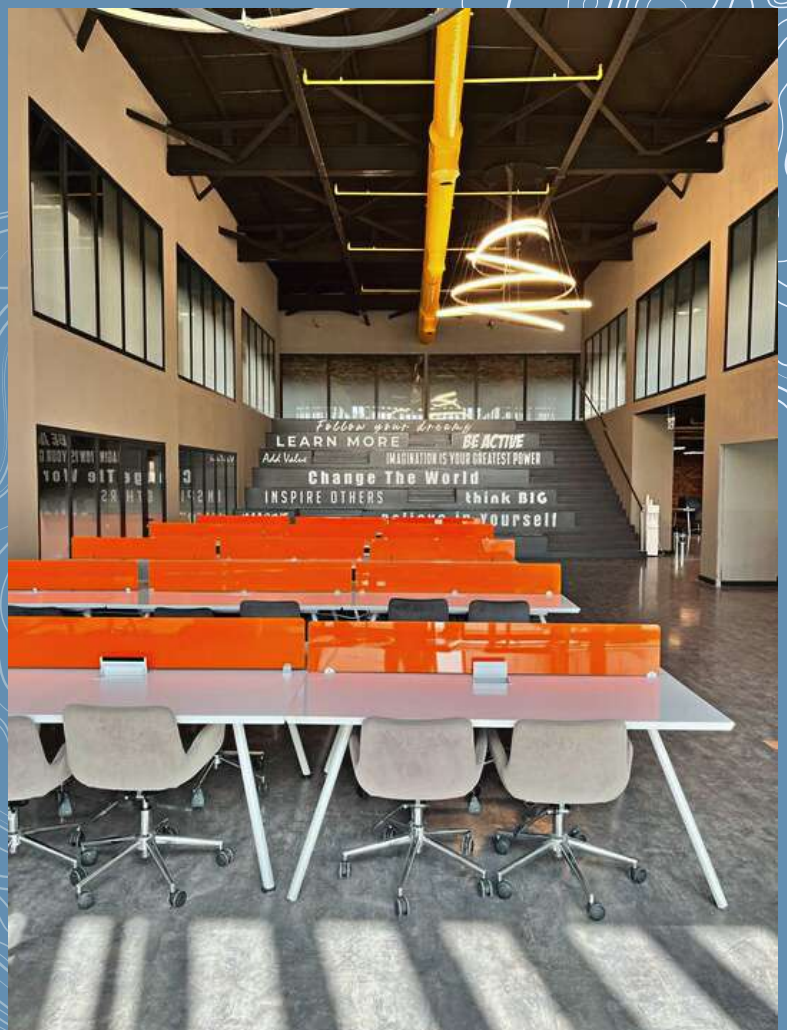

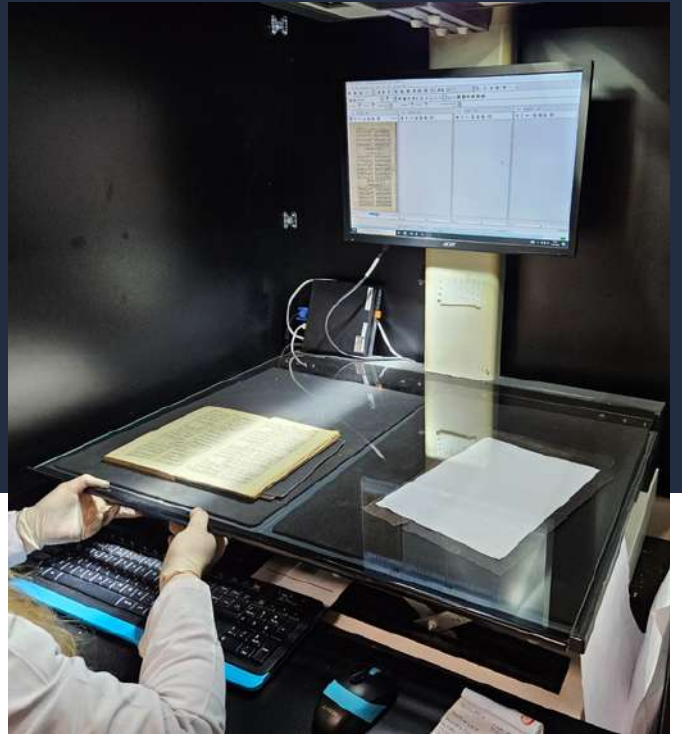

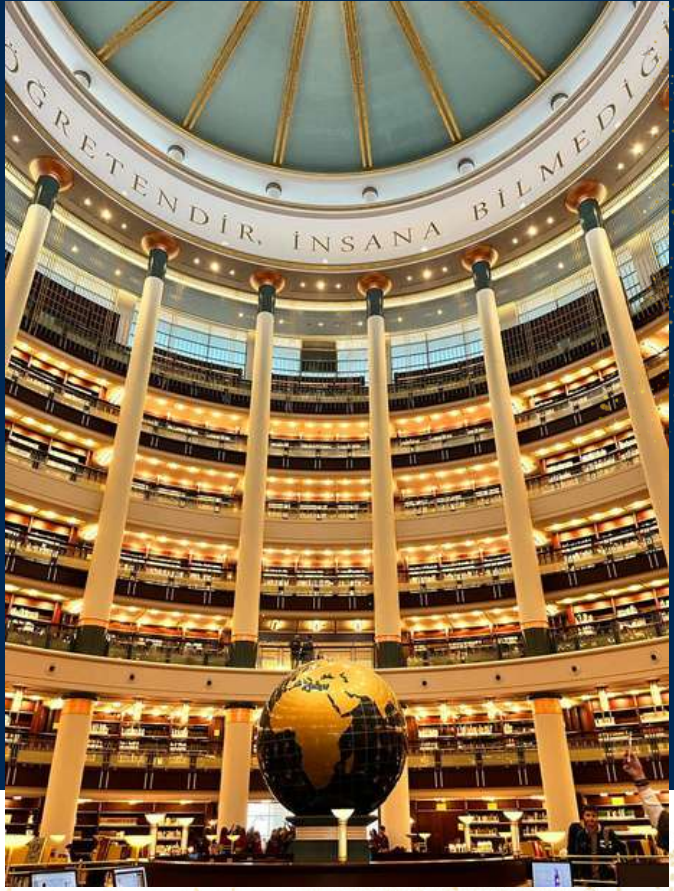

We visited the Nation's Library for the preparations for the Central Library, which will be put into service in a short time.



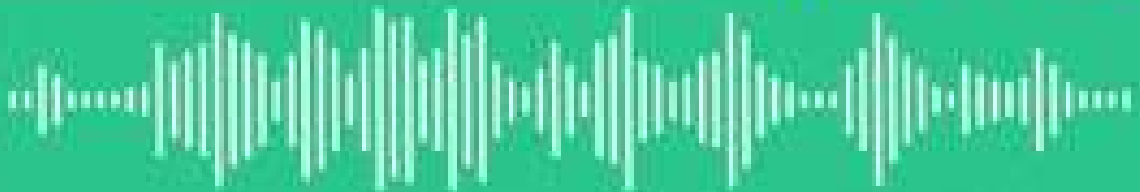

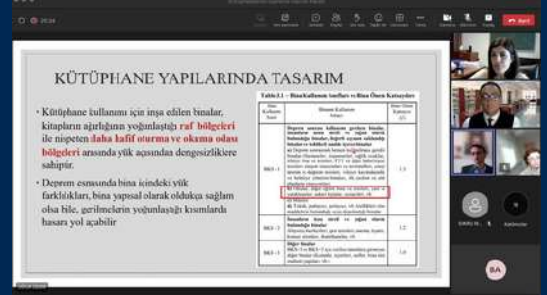

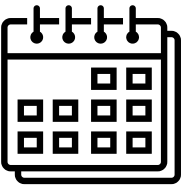
# TRAININGS WE ATTENDED IN APRIL

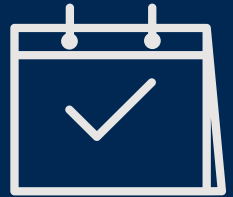

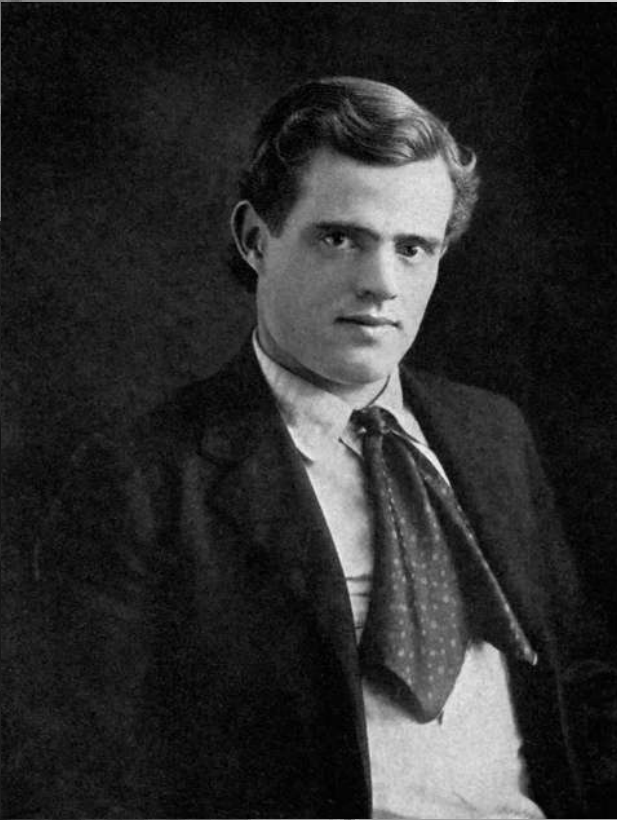

# AUTHOR OF THE MONTH



## JACK LONDON

(JANUARY 12, 1876 - NOVEMBER 22, 1916)

Born in San Francisco, Jack London's real name is John Griffith Chaney. Due to financial difficulties, he left school at a young age and worked in various jobs such as newspaper sales, crew, fishing, coast guard patrol. In this way, he recognized the American working class. He left the university, where he could study for a semester, due to financial difficulties. He joined the gold prospectors in the Klondike area in 1897, but returned a year later again poor and unemployed. He decided to try his luck as a writer by preparing a busy work schedule and started writing sonnets, ballads, witty anecdotes, horror and adventure stories. *Martin Eden*, written in 1909, bears autobiographical traces in terms of reflecting this period. London wrote nearly fifty books during his writing career and became one of the most widely read authors of his time. His writings were shaped around his experiences, and he reached a socialist world view with the influence of socialism.

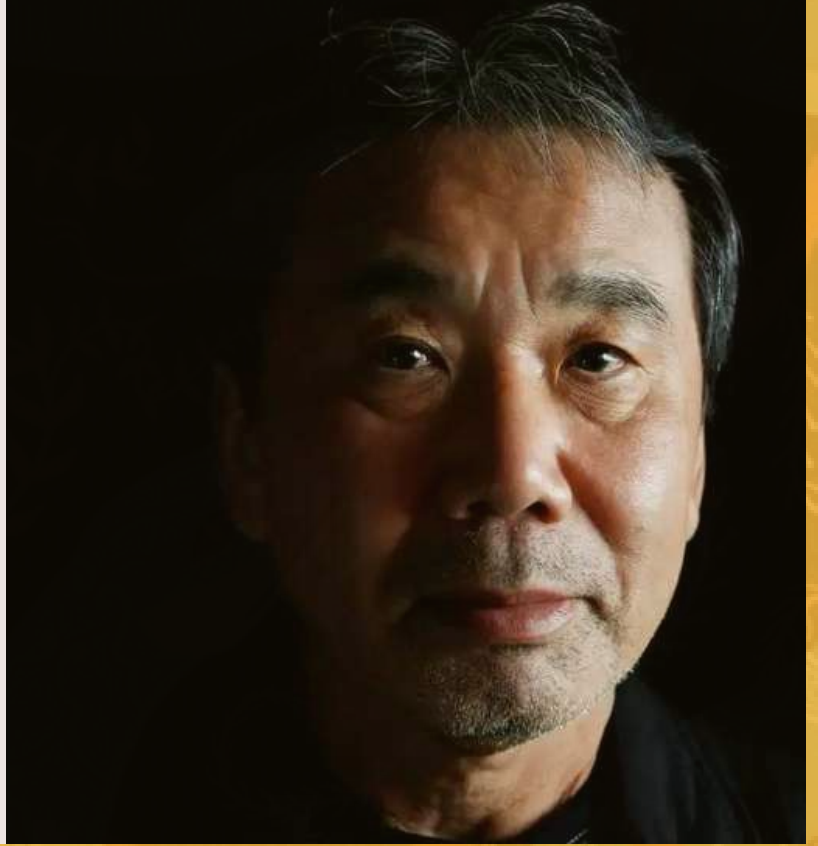


The exhibition features nearly 200 of Craxton's wide-ranging works, including a monumental tapestry, paintings, drawings, prints, book designs and personal items. 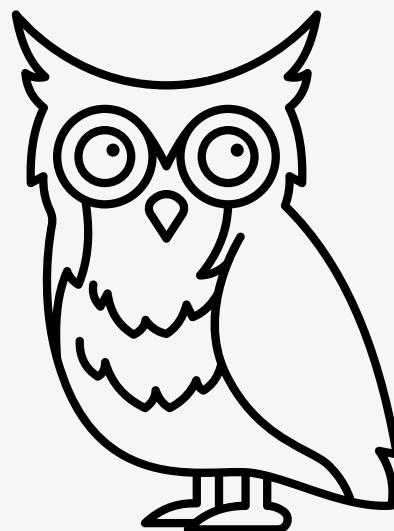
