

Seminar Content:

- Vision: To create a strong and integrated global library field area that strengthens literate, informed and participatory societies
- Mission: To inspire, engage, enable and connect the global library field
- At every opportunity, IFLA emphasizes the importance of "advocacy" and "awareness" of libraries in sustainability efforts.
- In Turkey, the umbrella organization for librarians is the Turkish Librarians Association.
- IFLA advocacy for libraries in NGOs has focused on the argument that increasing access to and the ability to use information and knowledge supports development and improves lives.
- "Literacy Information literacy"
- The IFLA Guidelines state that libraries should always work with decision-makers to ensure that libraries have a voice in the government's plan for how it will implement the Sustainable Development Goals.
- The Sustainable Development Goals consist of 17 articles and 169 sub-goals.

BUKET UZUNER





(October 3, 1955 -)

She studied biology and environmental science at Hacettepe University and METU, as well as at the University of Bergen (Norway) and the University of Michigan (USA). She worked as a researcher at Tampere Technical University (Finland).

Buket Uzuner, whose novels have been translated into ten languages, became an "honorary member" of the University of Iowa (USA) in 1996 and was honored with a certificate of appreciation by the METU Senate in 2004. In 2016, the author received the "Story Honor Award" given by Ankara University and Ankara Story Days Association.

Buket Uzuner was selected as one of the "75 Successful Women of the Republic" in the 75th anniversary of the founding of the Republic of Turkey by the votes of a jury composed of Turkish universities, press, professional organizations and the governorships of 81 provinces.

Her <u>"TABIAT FOURTEEN"</u> novels "Water", "Earth", "Air" and "Fire", in which she deals with "climate change" and environmental problems and uses fantastic elements from Turkish Mythology, continue to be published.

No Other Records Found: Reşad Ekrem Koçu and Istanbul Encyclopedia Archive



MAY 24 - OCTOBER 29, 2023

No Other Records: Reşad Ekrem Koçu and the Istanbul Encyclopedia Archive sheds light on the published sections of the Istanbul Encyclopedia, to which historian and novelist Reşad Ekrem Koçu (1905-1975) dedicated most of his life.

Spread across the floors of Salt Galata, the exhibition treats the building as an urban focus and presents its selection of materials within a framework built around the Galata neighborhood. It brings to the fore the exceptional urban image Koçu created of Galata and its immediate surroundings and its inhabitants from the early 19th century to the mid-20th century.

It traces the archival footprints of the "riffraff" who lived for a century in the urban space surrounding the building in question; those who lived relatively "freer" outside the traditional neighborhood order of Istanbul. Rather than repeating the house-neighborhood-monument-based narrative that dominates urban studies, this line pursues the uncanny elements under Koçu's guidance.



Turkish Librarians Association (TKD) Professional Ethical Principles

- 1. They defend the right of access to information, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, other international conventions and the TKD Declaration on Freedom of Thought, for all members of society and strive to fulfill its requirements.
- 2. They oppose censorship of intellectual and artistic works and defend freedom of thought.
- 3. They treat users equally without any discrimination.
- 4. They make active efforts in the development and implementation of professional policies and standards.
- 5. They provide accurate and sufficient information in a timely manner and perform their duties in a way that adds value to the profession.
- 6. Respect and protect copyrights.
- 7. Guarantee the confidentiality of users' research, borrowed and/or utilized information sources, and do not share their personal information with anyone except when legally required.
- 8. They do not engage in discourses and behaviors that are not based on objective data and that may damage the reputation of professional staff, a professional group in general or an information center with unfair slander.
- 9. They do not gain personal benefit while fulfilling their professional duties and responsibilities.
- 10. Pay attention to professional cooperation and solidarity.
- 11. They are sensitive about their professional development, continuously improve themselves in this respect and reflect this to their services.
- 12. They act fairly and honestly in their professional and managerial relations.
