

ISU LIBRARY IS GETTING READY FOR SERVICE WITH ITS NEW BUILDING




In the 2023-2024 Academic Year, the 2 floors of the 4-storey building of the İstinye University Library will be put into service for the users.

IN THE DESIGN OF THE LIBRARY BUILDING HIGHLIGHTS: SUSTAINABILITY



Today, libraries continue their services by redesigning and transforming buildings that were built with special designs determined by their architects or planned to be used for a different purpose. Buildings built or restructured as libraries can have direct or indirect effects on the environment. These buildings bring with them many negative environmental effects (such as energy, water use, production of wastes and the emergence of polluted gases) during the period when they are put into service, restored and demolished.



Increasing environmental threats together with these effects make it necessary to change in construction. Global changes and economic fluctuations together with the technology developing cause decrease in the resources on earth. New types of green buildings are needed to prevent this reduction. Building type and location affect library library services. Green buildings protect nature and minimize environmental pollution.

Istinye University Library was redesigned considering sustainability, the concept of green libraries and the demands of our users; With its 24/7 working area, group study rooms, individual study areas and plants... designing the building, important library buildings in Turkey were visited and examined. Istinye University Board of Trustees Chairman Dr. Muharrem Usta, Head of Information Resources and Library Department Bahar Biçen Aras, Head of Information Technologies and Department the team architects accompanying him visited the Presidential National Library and examined all library materials such as the design of the building, the shelf and table arrangement, the materials used, and the technical equipment.



It is a serious disorder of thermoregulation in which the body temperature rises uncontrollably.


Symptoms of heatstroke:

To avoid heatstroke:


- Stay in cool and shady places,

Science communicators develop strategies and methods to promote informed decisions about scientific issues. Through effective communication techniques, experts (e.g. scientists) can inform non-experts (e.g. members of the public) about scientific issues and increase public awareness and understanding of science. An informed public has the capacity to think, digest and make sound decisions about science in a democratic society. Scientists can also communicate their ideas and findings more effectively to each other.



WORLD CHESS DAY


This year marked the 57th anniversary of World Chess Day, which was declared by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) on July 20, 1966.

SHISTORY OF CHESS

There is evidence that chess was played in Egypt at least 4,000 years before our time on reliefs in the pyramids. It was also played in China, Mesopotamia and Anatolia. The game got its current name in India in the 3rd-4th centuries AD, when it was called ÇATURANGA. The first written documents about chess are from India.





MILAN KUNDERA

April 1, 1929 - July 11, 2023

Milan Kundera, author of The Unbearable Lightness of Being, Laughable Loves, Not Knowing and many other immortal works, is one of the most influential novelists of the 20th century.

Milan Kundera's career began with his novel "The Joke". His book "The Unbearable Lightness of Being", which won the Jerusalem Prize in 1985, was banned in his homeland until the late 80s. It was adapted into a movie by Philip Kaufman in 1988.

Milan Kundera, who has been professionally involved in music and cinema for many years, has written 16 works in various fields of literature and received numerous awards. Some of these are

- Medicis Prize (1973)
- Jerusalem Prize (1985)
- Austrian Prize for European Literature (1987)
- Herder Prize (2000)
- Czech National Prize (2007)
- Franz Kafka Prize (2020)





THE JOKE





Ludvik receives a letter from his girlfriend Marketa, from whom he has been estranged for some time. Marketa writes that she is happy with her life and that the revolution in the West will take place soon. Ludvik, angry with Marketa for not missing him, writes on the back of a postcard, "Optimism is the opium of mankind! A healthy spirit is nothing but a jerk. Long live Trotsky!" and sends it to her. These three sentences, which Ludvik wrote as a "joke", would lead to his expulsion from both the Communist Party and the university, and his ostracization from society.

Milan Kundera's first novel, The Joke, published in 1967, was a cynical critique of socialist Czechostovakia. After a while, all of Kundera's works were banned and he was stripped of his citizenship. Forty years have passed since The Joke was first published. This striking novel of love and revenge, which stood out in its time for its political references, continues to shed light on the universal themes of human existence today, like any enduring work.



On the occasion of its 100th anniversary, IBB opened the exhibition "Lausanne 1923/The Beginning of a Century Ago" at Casa Botter, focusing on the Lausanne Peace Conference. The exhibition, which describes the treaty process with period photographs and documents, will be on view until October 30.

The exhibition, organized by Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality (IBB) within the scope of the Centennial of Democracy events, exhibits pieces from external sources and private collections reflecting the traces of a century ago, especially the archives of IBB Atatürk Library and Inönü Foundation.







Journal Impact Factor

In English, impact factor (IF) is an important assessment tool for academic reputation.

The impact factor (IF) or journal impact factor (JIF) of an academic journal is a science-measurement index calculated by Clarivate that reflects the average annual number of citations received by articles published in a given journal in the last two years.

Turkish Librarians Association (TKD) Code of Ethics

- 1. They defend the right of access to information, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, other international conventions and the TKD Declaration on Freedom of Thought, for all members of society and strive to fulfill its requirements.
- 2. They oppose censorship of intellectual and artistic works and defend freedom of thought.
- 3. They treat users equally without any discrimination.
- 4. They make active efforts in the development and implementation of professional policies and standards.
- 5. They provide accurate and sufficient information in a timely manner and perform their duties in a way that adds value to the profession.
- 6. Respect and protect copyrights.
- 7. Guarantee the confidentiality of users' research, borrowed and/or utilized information sources, and do not share their personal information with anyone except when legally required.
- 8. They do not engage in discourses and behaviors that are not based on objective data and that may damage the reputation of professional staff, a professional group in general or an information center with unfair slander.
- 9. They do not gain personal benefit while fulfilling their professional duties and responsibilities.
- 10. Pay attention to professional cooperation and solidarity.
- 11. They are sensitive about their professional development, continuously improve themselves in this respect and reflect this to their services.
- 12. They act fairly and honestly in their professional and managerial relations.
