



Istinye University Library has prepared a guide to contribute to your knowledge about the impact of fake news on the world and the solutions available to help you deal with fake news. First of all, in order to be a good consumer and producer of information, we need to develop critical thinking skills. You can use this guide to develop these skills.

<u>The Guide</u> provides tips and fact-checking resources to help you distinguish whether the news and other information you see, read and hear is real or fake.

FAKE NEWS

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The Guide provides tips and fact-checking resources to help you distinguish whether the news and other information you see, read and hear is real or fake. With the Guide, you can become information literate and media literate and critically evaluate information (e.g. distinguish fake news from real news). You can also be aware of ethical and unethical uses of information, including plagiarism.

Ask a Librarian!



What is Fake News?

In the past, information was more strictly controlled by members of the media, journalists and librarians, but the open and ubiquitous nature of the digital world has made it difficult for these traditional gatekeepers to check and verify information. However, this spread of misinformation and disinformation has potentially devastating and dangerous consequences for the political and societal spheres (De Paor, Heravi, 2020, p. 1). We think that the information we share about what is fake news that affects our lives and how to detect it will help you.

Fake news is news that is printed or published knowing that it is not true. UNESCO's "Journalism, Fake News' and Disinformation: A Handbook for Journalism Training and Exercises" published by UNESCO defines fake news, mesinformation, disinformation and malinformation as follows:


If You are Stranded

In his hand, the supplement of Hürriyet dated February 13... "Look," he says, "at the cover of this reading book. I am the child on the cover prepared by İhap Hulusi. At that time, my father, Hasan Ali Yücel, was still the General Director of Secondary Education.

Years have passed. The boy on the cover is now sitting opposite me. Over the years, many children have grown up with his poems, which he described as "both a curse and a blessing". He is now an old plane tree. But what a plane tree!

Pera Museum hosts the works of Isabel Muñoz, who explores the nature, aesthetics and lifestyles of different cultures and reflects them in her photographs, focusing on Göbeklitepe, one of Turkey's most important archaeological sites, and the Stone Hills in the region. Curated by François Cheval, the exhibition offers the opportunity to explore Göbeklitepe, which is thought to be the oldest cult site in the world and has been on the UNESCO World Heritage List since 2018, as well as Karahantepe and Sayburç from Muñoz's impressive perspective.



Fake news is news that is printed or published knowing that it is not true.

Turkish Librarians Association (TKD) Code of Ethics

- 1. They defend the right of access to information, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, other international conventions and the TKD Declaration on Freedom of Thought, for all members of society and strive to fulfill its requirements.
- 2. They oppose censorship of intellectual and artistic works and defend freedom of thought.
- 3. They treat users equally without any discrimination.
- 4. They make active efforts in the development and implementation of professional policies and standards.
- 5. They provide accurate and sufficient information in a timely manner and perform their duties in a way that adds value to the profession.
- 6. Respect and protect copyrights.
- 7. Guarantee the confidentiality of users' research, borrowed and/or utilized information sources, and do not share their personal information with anyone except when legally required.
- 8. They do not engage in discourses and behaviors that are not based on objective data and that may damage the reputation of professional staff, a professional group in general or an information center with unfair slander.
- 9. They do not gain personal benefit while fulfilling their professional duties and responsibilities.
- 10. Pay attention to professional cooperation and solidarity.
- 11. They are sensitive about their professional development, continuously improve themselves in this respect and reflect this to their services.
- 12. They act fairly and honestly in their professional and managerial relations.
