




The academics of İstinye University, which is rapidly progressing towards a Research University, continue to produce.

Taking into account the information needs of students, academic and administrative staff, ISU Library aims to promote and facilitate scholarly participation by providing access to both traditional and innovative resources, fostering excellence in lifelong learning, teaching and research, encouraging and facilitating scholarly participation, and striving to be an inclusive place for innovative research and development by collaborating with colleagues.

İstinye University Central Library is located in Vadi Main Campus, Topkapı Library is located next to the Congress Center (former Student Center) in Topkapı Campus, Liv Hospital Bahçeşehir Faculty of Medicine Library is located in Liv Hospital Bahçeşehir, and Medical Park Gaziosmanpaşa Faculty of Medicine Library is located in Medical Park Gaziosmanpaşa.

ISU Libraries are at the center of research with a total area of 3,383.50 m2, a collection of approximately 43 thousand printed and 200 thousand e-resources and 52 databases with a seating capacity of 631 in group study rooms, super quiet study spaces and research halls.














Author of the Month

Halide Edip Adıvar

In the Republican Era, she produced works in many genres such as novels, stories, memoirs, theater poetry. Halide Edip Adıvar, who is among the writers who maintain the taste and understanding of National Literature, is referred to in her biography as a witness of her age, a pioneer and a country literary figure. Halide Edip Adıvar is a Turkish novelist, educator, politician and academician.



She published her first articles in Tanin Newspaper under the pseudonym "Halide Salih".

Halide Edip Adıvar's life was spent briefly working for the participation and education of women in social life and reflecting the inner life of the people. She worked as a teacher, inspector, deputy and academic.

Halide Edip Adıvar actually participated in the national struggle and worked in Red Crescent hospitals. After the occupation of Izmir, she participated in many rallies as a speaker.

She is the first well-known female novelist and storyteller of the National Literature Period.

Her works act as a mirror of the period. Halide Edip Adıvar is a writer of the 2nd Constitutional Monarchy and Republican Period.




With the update made in the Institutional Academic Archive, you can provide easy access to publications with the filters added from the Analysis section.





You can review collections with index information such as WoS, Scopus, Pubmed.

With DSpace, all kinds of documents produced within the institution can be archived, preserved for a long time and made available on the internet in accordance with copyright. By providing academic metadata and access information to search engines at international standards, DSpace increases the visibility and citation numbers of the institution on the internet.





LIBRARIAN SUGGESTS MUSEUM DENIZ MUSEUM

The Naval Museum was established in 1897 in a small building at the Shipyard-i Amire under the name of "Museum and Library Administration" with the permission of Abdülhamit II and the orders of Minister of Naval Affairs Hasan Hüsnü Pasha of Bozcaada. The museum, which served in different buildings at various times due to periodic conditions, finally moved to its current location in Beşiktaş (formerly used as the finance building) in 1961 and started to serve under the name of "Directorate of Naval Museum and Archive".

In 2005, an architectural project competition was launched. In 2008, the tender for the new museum building was finalized and the construction of the museum, which consists of the Main Exhibition Building, Historical Boats Gallery, Cultural Site and Open Exhibition Areas, was started in accordance with the modern museum concept. First, a temporary warehouse was built to protect the historical boats during the construction process and the boats were moved to this warehouse in 2009. In 2013, restoration works were completed and the Gallery of Historical Boats was opened to visitors on October 04, 2013.



We are used to science books: evolution, quantum physics, medicine, botany, cosmology, geology, chemistry, neuroscience and so on... But how well equipped are we with the most fundamental philosophical stance at the heart of science: scientific skepticism? How good are we at distinguishing between what is real and what is not? Do we know how to distinguish between truth and falsehood, fact and nonsense, or do we just trust our "gut instincts", our prejudices?

The main purpose of this book is to equip you with a culture of scientific skepticism, so that your toolkit will be much richer and more diverse on your journey into the dizzying world of science.

Are lost cities at the bottom of the oceans waiting to be discovered? Are there mysterious monsters roaming the forests? Have aliens visited ancient people? Are there chakras in our bodies? Are the photos of astronauts walking on the Moon fake? Does astrology have any validity today? Is astral travel possible? Can we move objects with just our mind power?

For some, these questions may seem ridiculous, but for us, like many people, they are important questions. Because the only way to find the truth of something is to discover what is false about it. We get to the truth by carefully identifying and eliminating the untruth.

Why is an argument false? Why is an argument unlikely to be true? Why is a belief so exaggerated that it can be called superstition? This is what skeptics, who are interested in scientific skepticism today, are investigating and searching for the truth behind the veil of mystery.

Of course, we do not have all the secrets of the universe, but we invite you to look at life from a more scientific perspective for a while. Already, commit to memory the following sentence that will echo in your brain throughout the book:

"Until proven otherwise, everything we believe or assume to be true is false."


