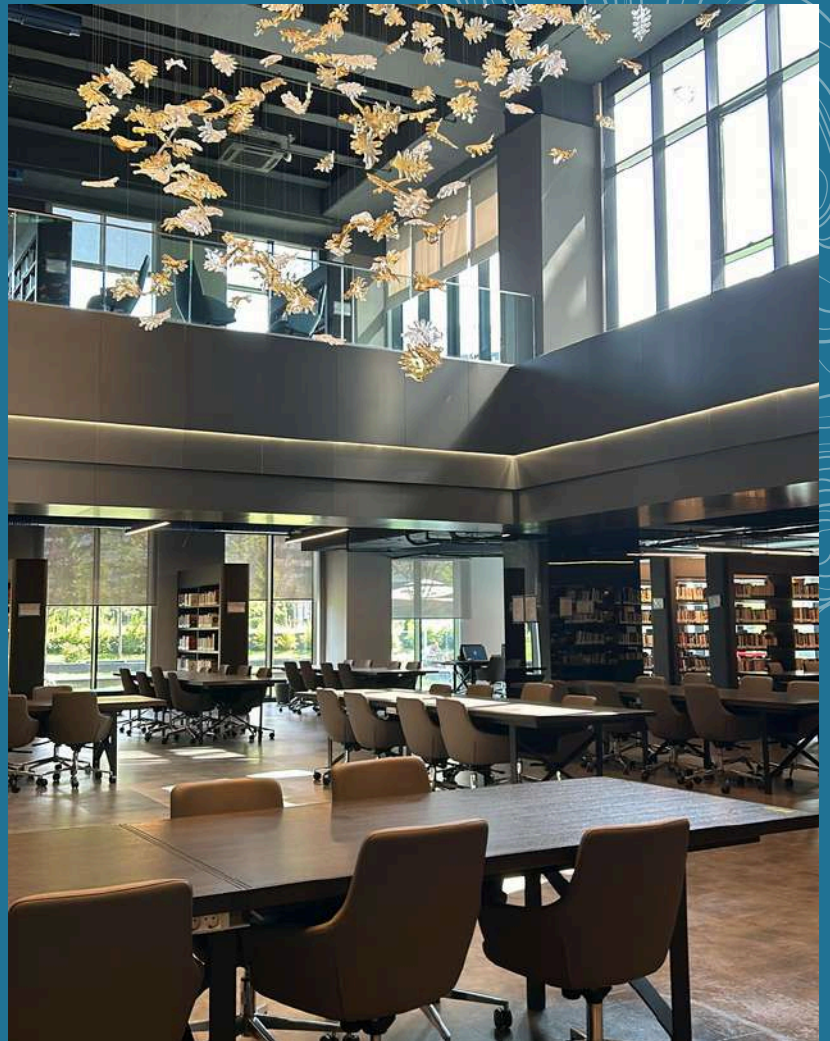

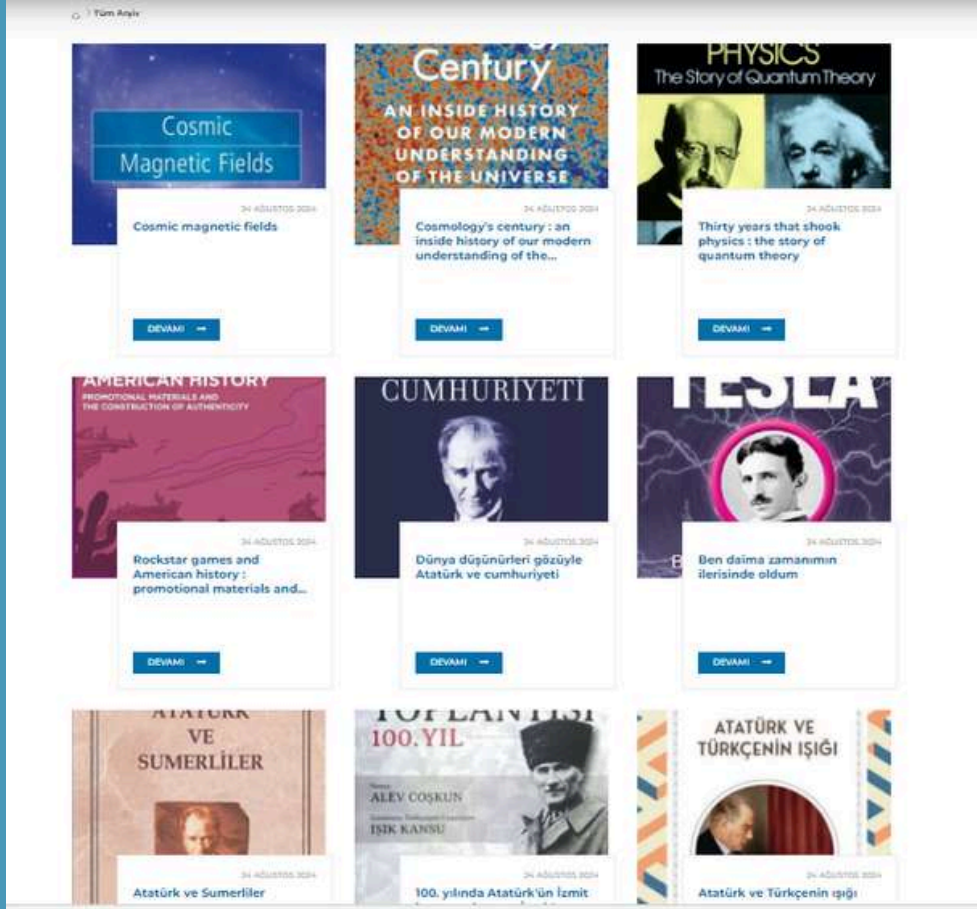

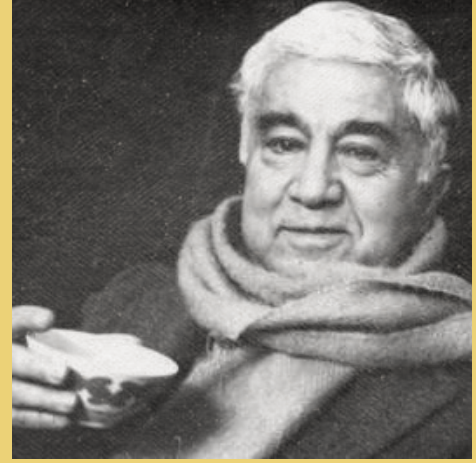

# AUTHOR OF THE MONTH

## AZİZ NESİN

20 DECEMBER 1915 - 6 JULY 1995

AZİZ NESİN, WHO WROTE MANY WORKS IN THE FIELDS OF HUMOR, SHORT STORIES, NOVELS, POETRY AND THEATER DURING THE REPUBLICAN ERA, IS THE 4TH AUTHOR WHOSE WORKS HAVE BEEN TRANSLATED INTO FOREIGN LANGUAGES THE MOST AMONG THE WRITERS WHO WROTE TURKISH WORKS ACCORDING TO UNESCO'S WORLD TRANSLATION BIBLIOGRAPHY.



AZİZ NESİN, WHO WROTE MANY WORKS IN THE FIELDS OF HUMOR, SHORT STORIES, NOVELS, POETRY AND THEATER DURING THE REPUBLICAN PERIOD, IS THE 4TH AUTHOR WHOSE WORKS HAVE BEEN TRANSLATED INTO FOREIGN LANGUAGES THE MOST AMONG THE AUTHORS WHO WROTE TURKISH WORKS ACCORDING TO UNESCO'S WORLD TRANSLATION BIBLIOGRAPHY.

THE NOVEL "YAŞAR NE YAŞAMAZ" IS ONE OF AZİZ NESİN'S MOST FAMOUS WORKS. THE NOVEL "ZÜBÜK", WHICH IS AMONG THE CLASSICS OF TURKISH LITERATURE, WAS ADAPTED TO THE CINEMA IN 1980. AZİZ NESİN'S UNIQUE WRITING STYLES HAVE ADDED DIVERSITY TO HIS WORKS. USES SUCH AS CANDARMA, NAGRA, HERYAN ARE INCLUDED IN HIS WORKS.

IN 1972, AZİZ NESİN AND HIS WIFE MERAL ÇELEN FOUNDED THE NESİN FOUNDATION, WHICH UNDERTAKES THE CARE AND EDUCATION OF A CERTAIN NUMBER OF ORPHANS AND POOR CHILDREN EVERY YEAR. ALL THE INCOME FROM THE AUTHOR'S BOOKS ALSO GOES TO THIS FOUNDATION. AZİZ NESİN PASSED AWAY ON JULY 6, 1995.

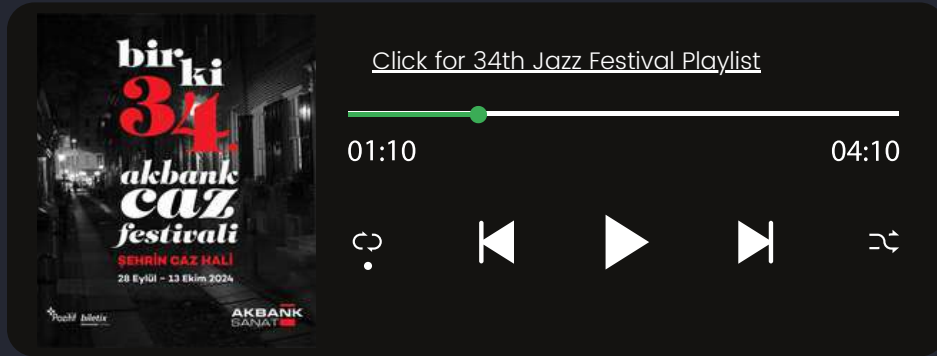
# LIBRARIAN SUGGESTS FESTIVAL

# LIBRARIAN SUGGESTS BOOK



## BEYAZ ZAMBAKLAR ÜLKESİNDE GRIGORIY PETROV

Published in 1923 in Serbian under the title “Zidari Zhivota” (Architects of Life), the book was translated into Turkish for the first time in 1928 by Ali Haydar Taner. As in Russia, Yugoslavia and Bulgaria, the book had a great impact in Turkey. In the Land of White Lilies was translated into Turkish for the first time during the time of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. When Atatürk read the book, he was simply amazed by this epic achievement. He immediately ordered the book to be included in the curriculum of schools in the country, especially military schools. Turkish soldiers had to read this book to “renew life” in their country. At the time, the book attracted so much attention that it became the most widely read book.

This book is an example to all humanity of how, despite all poverty, impossibilities and unfavorable natural conditions, under the leadership of a handful of intellectuals, people of all professions, from soldiers to clergymen, from professors to teachers, from doctors to businessmen, demonstrated solidarity shoulder to shoulder and fought a great struggle to save Finland and their country from backwardness.

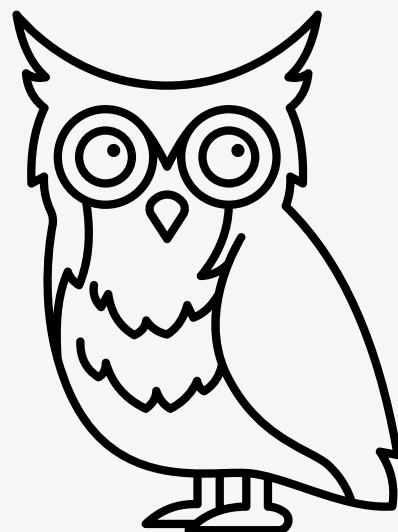

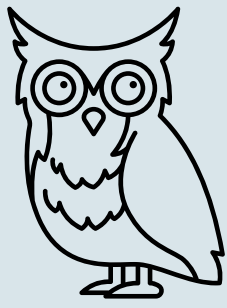
## Researcher Profile

## *Code of Ethics*

- 1. They defend the right of access to information, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, other international conventions and the TKD Declaration on Freedom of Thought, for all members of society and strive to fulfill its requirements.*
- 2. They oppose censorship of intellectual and artistic works and defend freedom of thought.*
- 3. They treat users equally without any discrimination.*
- 4. They make active efforts in the development and implementation of professional policies and standards.*
- 5. They provide accurate and sufficient information in a timely manner and perform their duties in a way that adds value to the profession.*
- 6. Respect and protect copyrights.*
- 7. Guarantee the confidentiality of users' research, borrowed and/or utilized information sources, and do not share their personal information with anyone except when legally required.*
- 8. They do not engage in discourses and behaviors that are not based on objective data and that may damage the reputation of professional staff, a professional group in general or an information center with unfair slander.*
- 9. They do not gain personal benefit while fulfilling their professional duties and responsibilities.*
- 10. Pay attention to professional cooperation and solidarity.*
- 11. They are sensitive about their professional development, continuously improve themselves in this respect and reflect this to their services.*
- 12. They act fairly and honestly in their professional and managerial relations.*

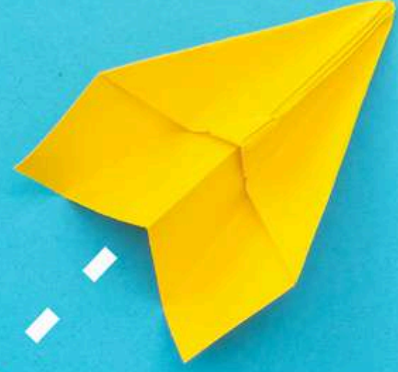
