

Open access means that scholarly publications are directly searchable on the web, available in digital form on the internet under an open license and available for anyone to read, download, copy and distribute the material in accordance with Copyright.

All research outputs published with the address of İstinye University must be archived in the University's Institutional Academic Archive. Thus, the data of all studies belonging to the University will be accessible within the framework of copyright. It encourages researchers to actively inform about research results and inform the public about them.

It encourages publishing research outputs in open access peer-reviewed journals with high impact value. Publishing the studies and research results of research groups with the address of İstinye University on an open access basis increases the reliability and reproducibility of the studies as well as increasing scientific communication among researchers. In addition, these academic outputs contribute to the researches carried out in different projects to reach results in a shorter time thanks to open science.

POETRY.




ORHAN VELİ REFUSED TO USE THE SYLLABIC AND PROSODY METERS IN ORDER TO CREATE A NEW TASTE. HIS WORKS, WHICH WENT BEYOND THE TRADITIONS, ALWAYS AROUSED INTEREST, EVEN THOUGH THEY WERE FIRST MET WITH ASTONISHMENT AND DISBELIEF, THEN AMUSEMENT AND CONTEMPT. ALTHOUGH HE CAME TO THE FOREFRONT WITH HIS POEMS WRITTEN DURING THE STRANGE PERIOD, ORHAN VELİ AVOIDED WRITING "ONE-GENRE" POEMS. KANIK'S LITERARY LIFE CONSISTED OF DIFFERENT STAGES, AS HE CONSTANTLY SEARCHED, RENEWED HIMSELF AND EXPERIENCED A LONG POETRY ADVENTURE DURING HIS SHORT LIFE.

BUILT ON A HIGH LAND
OVERLOOKING THE
BOSPHORUS AND MARMARA
SEA, YILDIZ PALACE WAS THE
LAST GREAT PALACE BUILT BY
THE OTTOMAN EMPIRE IN

THE FIRST PAVILION IN THE YILDIZ PALACE AREA WAS BULIT DURING THE REIGN OF SULTAN SELİM III (1789-1807). ALTHOUGH SUBSEQUENT SULTANS SHOWED INTEREST IN THE GROVES AND GARDENS IN THE REGION, THE NAME OF YILDIZ PALACE BECAME SYNONYMOUS WITH SULTAN ABDÜLHAMİD II (1876-1909).

THE SULTAN NAMED THE AREA
"YILDIZ PALACE" AND DESIGNATED
IT AS HIS PRIMARY RESIDENCE.
YILDIZ PALACE WENT DOWN IN
HISTORY AS THE LAST
ADMINISTRATIVE CENTER OF THE
OTTOMAN EMPIRE AND THE LAST
RESIDENCE OF THE SULTAN.

LIBRARIAN SUGGESTS EXHIBITION Farz Et Ki





SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 10,2024 TIME: 11:30



DOĞANIN SONU

BILL MCKIBBEN

Doğanın sonu is a book that tells the story of how man is irreversibly changing the climate of the entire world and is rapidly leading a large part of the living world to extinction, as the scientific community first demonstrated almost a century ago, and then proved with mathematical certainty at increasingly frequent intervals until today. The first book on global warming. And it does so in a very clear and simple language that ordinary people, all of us, can understand." - Ömer Madra What is global warming? Why does it occur? Is nature, as we often think, an ancient friend that never changes and will never come to an end, or is there an end to nature as we know it?

More importantly, do we have the chance to change the future of our planet? This book is a work that seeks answers to all these questions and invites the reader to think about both today and tomorrow. This fundamental text of McKibben, which continues to remain relevant, is being published in Turkish for the first time. The foreword written by the author specifically for the Turkish edition and the introduction written by Ömer Madra also function as a review of the developments since the book was first published in 1989. With the rigor of a scientist and the style of a man of letters, McKibben puts before us the problems that no one living in the world can remain indifferent to. As he reiterates in his preface to the Turkish edition: "We no longer have to warm the climate. We can keep our world spinning in other ways. But this requires foresight, courage and good management." "It is like a kind of song for nature, an elegy for the lost and a plea for action.



Turkish Librarians Association (TKD) Code of Ethics

- 1. They defend the right of access to information, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, other international conventions and the TKD Declaration on Freedom of Thought, for all members of society and strive to fulfill its requirements.
- 2. They oppose censorship of intellectual and artistic works and defend freedom of thought.
- 3. They treat users equally without any discrimination.
- 4. They make active efforts in the development and implementation of professional policies and standards.
- 5. They provide accurate and sufficient information in a timely manner and perform their duties in a way that adds value to the profession.
- 6. Respect and protect copyrights.
- 7. Guarantee the confidentiality of users' research, borrowed and/or utilized information sources, and do not share their personal information with anyone except when legally required.
- 8. They do not engage in discourses and behaviors that are not based on objective data and that may damage the reputation of professional staff, a professional group in general or an information center with unfair slander.
- 9. They do not gain personal benefit while fulfilling their professional duties and responsibilities.
- 10. Pay attention to professional cooperation and solidarity.
- 11. They are sensitive about their professional development, continuously improve themselves in this respect and reflect this to their services.
- 12. They act fairly and honestly in their professional and managerial relations.
