

WHAT IS OPEN ACCESS?

Open access addresses the problem of limited access to scientific outputs, often caused by high subscription fees. It is the practice of providing readers with free access to scientific information (articles, books, research data) and the licensing of this information to make it more widely used by researchers, industry and citizens.



OPEN SCIENCE AT ISTINYE UNIVERSITY

It encourages publishing research outputs in open access peer-reviewed journals with high impact value. Publishing the studies and research results of research groups with the address of İstinye University on an open access basis increases the reliability and reproducibility of the studies as well as increasing scientific communication among researchers. In addition, these academic outputs contribute to the researches carried out in different projects to reach results in a shorter time thanks to open science.



First of all, in order to be a good consumer and producer of information, we need to develop critical thinking skills. You can use this guide to develop these skills.



The Guide provides tips and fact-checking resources to help you distinguish whether the news and other information you see, read and hear is real or fake. With the Guide, you can become information literate and media literate and critically evaluate information (e.g. distinguish fake news from real news). You can also be aware of ethical and unethical uses of information, including plagiarism.





BORN ON NOVEMBER 21, 1960 IN YOZGAT, HE IS A NOVELIST AND SHORT STORY WRITER.

AFTER COMPLETING HIS UNDERGRADUATE, GRADUATE AND DOCTORAL STUDIES AT EGE UNIVERSITY, FACULTY OF LITERATURE, DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY, HE RETIRED FROM THE SAME DEPARTMENT AS A FACULTY MEMBER IN 2011.

IN 1995, HE PUBLISHED HIS FIRST NOVEL, "PUSLU KITALAR ATLASI", WHICH WAS TRANSLATED INTO MORE THAN TWENTY LANGUAGES AND RECEIVED MUCH ATTENTION AND ACCLAIM BOTH IN TERMS OF CONTENT AND FORM. HIS NOVEL "EFRÂSIYÂB'IN HİKÂYELERİ" WAS ADAPTED AND STAGED AS A THEATER PLAY IN ENGLAND.

ANAR WAS AWARDED THE ERDAL ÖZ LITERATURE PRIZE IN 2009.



Sebastião Salgado - Genesis 28 September - 31 December

World-renowned photographer Sebastião Salgado's "Genesis" exhibition, one of the longestrunning and most important projects of his career, can be visited at MSGSU Tophane-i Amire Culture and Art Center until December 31, 2024.

Sebastião Salgado, one of the leading documentary photographers and activists of our time, is known for his impressive black-and-white images reflecting the harsh living and working conditions, poverty, hunger and migration in the underdeveloped countries of the world. The "Genesis" project, consisting of 245 black-and-white photographs to be exhibited in Istanbul for 3 months, is a "love letter dedicated to our world" in Salgado's words, which he worked on between 2004 and 2011.



Turkish Librarians Association (TKD) Code of Ethics

- 1. They defend the right of access to information, as enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, other international conventions and the TKD Declaration on Freedom of Thought, for all members of society and strive to fulfill its requirements.
- 2. They oppose censorship of intellectual and artistic works and defend freedom of thought.
- 3. They treat users equally without any discrimination.
- 4. They make active efforts in the development and implementation of professional policies and standards.
- 5. They provide accurate and sufficient information in a timely manner and perform their duties in a way that adds value to the profession.
- 6. Respect and protect copyrights.
- 7. Guarantee the confidentiality of users' research, borrowed and/or utilized information sources, and do not share their personal information with anyone except when legally required.
- 8. They do not engage in discourses and behaviors that are not based on objective data and that may damage the reputation of professional staff, a professional group in general or an information center with unfair slander.
- 9. They do not gain personal benefit while fulfilling their professional duties and responsibilities.
- 10. Pay attention to professional cooperation and solidarity.
- 11. They are sensitive about their professional development, continuously improve themselves in this respect and reflect this to their services.
- 12. They act fairly and honestly in their professional and managerial relations.
