Istinye University Information Resources Directorate; With its 9 Faculties, 2 Vocational Schools, 3 Institutes and the centers and laboratories under these units, İstinye University has been trying to provide the necessary information and resources to its academicians, students and administrative staff since the day it started its education life. 


### BLUE SUITS VERY WELL TO ISU LIBRARY



## ISTANBUL CULTURAL HERITAGE DIGITAL LIBRARY (DIGITALLIBRARYIST) ISTKA PROJECT






Within the scope of Istanbul Development Agency "Innovative Istanbul Financial Support Program" TR10/21/YEP/051 Istanbul Cultural Heritage Digital Library;

- Releasing the catalog tags of 35,000 cultural heritage rare works in accordance with international librarianship standards,

- Digitizing approximately 700,000 (seven hundred thousand) images (pages) of the works with a scanner

- It is aimed to develop a new automation/digital content scanning system and software.



## AUTHOR OF THE MONTH




#### Sabahattin Ali


He was born on February 25, 1907 in Komotini, he was killed on April 2, 1948 in Kırklareli. After graduating from Istanbul Primary Teachers' School, Sabahattin Ali was sent to Germany in 1928 by the Ministry of National Education, after teaching for a year in Yozgat. After returning in 1930, he worked as a German teacher in Aydın, Konya and Ankara secondary schools, as a civil servant in the Publication Directorate of the Ministry of National Education, and as a dramaturg in the State Conservatory. He was taken under the command of the Ministry in 1945, he published the humor newspaper Markopaşa in Istanbul. He was arrested for an article in 1948, and spent three months in prison. He wanted to flee abroad because he was constantly watched, but it was claimed that he was killed by a smuggler around Kırklareli. He wrote poems, stories, novels and made translations. His first articles were published in Irmak magazine in Balıkesir (1925/26). Sabahattin Ali brought a realistic and new breath to the story in the 1930s.

## **SUGGESIIONS FROM THE LIBRARIAN**




Two hostile families living in Verona, Italy... And the children of these hostile families in love with each other... What is love? An innocent feeling or an obsession that turns into danger? What does he do for human love? What does he do for human love? What does it go against? What does he give up? Romeo and Juliet, Shakespeare's world's most known romantic tragedy, will be at DasDas on April 29.



#### TO REACH SHAKESPEARE'S "ROMEO AND JULIEC" AC ISU LIBRARY

The Rainforest series originated when choreographer Merce Cunningham ordered a piece of music from David Tudor for a dance show of the same name in 1968. In this interactive installation, 20 finds and structured objects such as large buoys, plastic barrels, a copper cauldron, a flower pot, and a badminton racket disperse through the air, while the differently intervened and combined objects vibrate with signals from the pre-recorded audio files, clearly promoting the discovery of the audience. They create a sustained soundscape. The exhibitions For Listening Eyes and Rainforest V (variation 3), which are held simultaneously at Arter, are closely related to each other through the concepts of sound and silence, and work as a single exhibition with two components. You can visit the exhibition until April 30, 2022.
